The Legacies of Bob and Jerrie Glenn

Stop by to see Bob Glenn these days and he is likely to be out on his bicycle – an activity he has enjoyed for many decades. In fact, Bob helped organize the now-famous bike ride across Iowa (RAGBRAI) that began in the early 1970s. Today, Bob is well into his ninth decade and finds the bicycle is just one way to maintain his forward motion.

Bob, and his wife Jerrie, are also interested in helping children move forward with faith and fun at Missouri's United Methodist camps. "Our granddaughters had a wonderful experience at Camp Galilee," the UM camp near Eldorado Springs, Missouri. So, a couple of years ago the Glenns created an endowment fund at the Foundation to help pay camp fees for children in need. The Glenn United Methodist Camp Scholarship Fund has already helped over 50 children and youth attend one of the four United Methodist camps around the state.

Lee Walz, director of camping and retreat ministries, states that the Glenn Fund "is already making a huge impact," even helping some parent camp volunteers "who would not have been able to send their own children without the help of the fund."

Bob and Jerrie stay active at their church (Branson UMC), the Branson senior center (Bob is a frequent Master of Ceremonies), and by volunteering in the community. But this is just the latest chapter in a very full and extraordinary life – trick motorcycle performer, Iowa State Trooper, founding chief education officer for the Iowa State Patrol, expert pistol marksman, national board of Toastmasters International, avid Aladdin Lamp collector, UMCOR mission to Ghana, children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren – all are aspects of the Glenn legacy.

Dollars for Scholars

Dollars for Scholars is a national scholarship-matching program set up through the United Methodist Higher Education Foundation (UMHEF) that enables local United Methodist churches, conference foundations, United Methodist related schools, and UMHEF to provide scholarships to United Methodist students.

How it works is a local United Methodist Church awards a student who is planning to attend a United Methodist related college, university, or seminary with a \$1,000 scholarship in which UMHEF will match to total \$2,000. If the student is attending a participating United Methodist related school the student will receive an additional \$1,000 from the institution. If eligible, the student will also receive an additional \$1,000 from the conference foundation totaling a scholarship award of \$4,000.

In 2013 your Missouri United Methodist Foundation awarded \$43,000 in matching grants to Missouri students attending Central Methodist University and St. Paul School of Theology under the Dollars for Scholars program of the United Methodist Higher Education Foundation.

Merrydelle G. May Memorial Fund

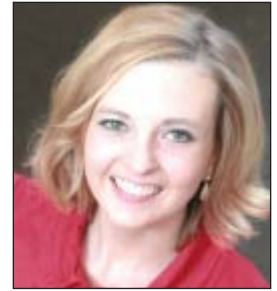

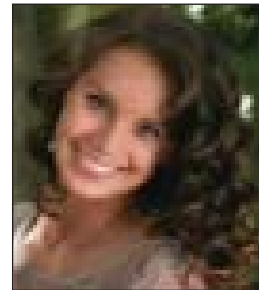

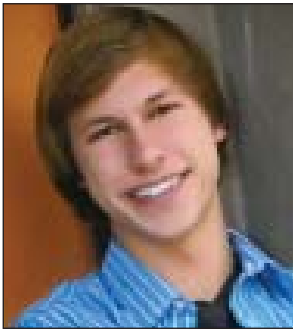
