The Zion United Methodist Church in Truxton, Missouri, originated in the 1800's as a German Methodist Church, serving the German – speaking immigrants who came to the area to farm.

"...[Truxton] had two churches, Methodist Episcopal and Lutheran, a high school, steam saw-mill and grist mill, a newspaper, the "Republican", a hotel, and about fifteen stores, shops, etc. Population, 1899 (estimated) 250."
